Parrott moved to place Ordinance #167AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AFTON, IOWA 1998, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL FEES on it's first reading. Williams seconded the motion. Roll call votes of aye: Parrott, Williams, Cunningham, Tunnicliff and Burger. Motion carried. This Ordinance raises our garbage collection fee from \$11.00 to 11.50 per month due to the City

receiving an increase from Waste Management. The second reading of Ordinance #167 will be on May 11, 2006.

Williams moved to approve a \$1200.00 yr. raise for Greenlawn Cemetery care taker/grave opener Terrinda McIntire effective May 1, 2006. Parrott seconded the motion. With roll call votes of all ayes, the motion carried.

Parrott moved to appoint Andrew Siddens to the Board of Adjustment to replace Don Damewood who moved out of the city limits. Cunningham seconded the motion. All voting aye, the motion carried. Siddens term will be until 2-03-08.

Jason Weinkoetz met with the Council requesting a tree be removed on the west side of his property in the city right of way. A decision will be made on this after bids for removal are received.

Discussion was held on the 2006 street project, park improvements and several maintenance projects.

At 8:02 P.M., Williams moved to go into closed session pursuant to Chapter 20.17(3) of the Iowa Code for union negotiations. Parrott seconded the motion. Roll call votes of aye: Williams, Parrott, Cunningham, Tunncliff and Burger. Motion carried. Closed session ended at 8:25 P.M.

The May council meeting was changed to Thursday, May 11, 2006.

Parrott moved to adjourn. Tunncliff seconded the motion. All voting aye, the Council adjourned at 8:27 P.M.
