The Afton City Council met in City Hall in regular session at 7:00 P.M. March 14, 2006. Mayor Michelle Burger presided with Council members Jeff Burger, Dave Cunningham, Sherry Parrott, Ann Tunnicliff and Cindy Williams present.

Tunnicliff moved to approve the consent agenda which consisted of the agenda, reports from the City Clerk, City Treasurer, JOY Group, Director of Afton Housing Commission, Afton Police Chief; minutes of the February 14 & 23 and March 7, 2006 meetings, and the following bills. Williams seconded the motion. With roll call votes of all ayes, the motion carried.

Lynn Kruse, Chairman of the Afton Recreation Board, reported that a large number of kids have participated in the various sports programs sponsored by the City. Kruse also informed the Council of improvements made to the sports complex and some future plans. The Council commended Kruse and the Recreation Board for their time and dedication to the recreation program.

Scott Nixon, Chairman of the Greenlawn Cemetery Board, informed the Council that the Cemetery Board had met and recommended the Council raise the cemetery caretakers contract by \$3000.00 yr. This will be considered at the April 11, 2006 meeting.

Five bids were received for the mowing of the Recreation Complex. Tunncliff moved to accept the bid of \$2790.00 submitted by Mike's Services Snow Removal & Lawn Care. Parrott seconded the motion. Roll call votes of ayes: Tunncliff and Parrott. Nays: Cunningham, Williams and Burger. Motion failed.

Burger moved to accept the bid of \$2550.00 submitted by Matt Waigand for the mowing of the Recreation Complex for 2006. Cunningham seconded the motion. Roll call votes of ayes: Burger, Cunningham, Parrott, Williams and Tunnicliff. Motion carried.

At 7:40 P.M., the Mayor opened the public hearing on the proposed 2005-06 budget amendment. There were no comments for or against the amendment and no written comments had been received. The Mayor closed the public hearing at 7:42 P.M.

Williams moved to approve Resolution 2006-11 RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CURRENT BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2006. Parrott seconded the motion. Roll call votes of ayes: Williams, Parrott, Cunningham, Tunnicliff & Burger. Motion carried.

Williams moved to approve Resolution 2006-12 RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO LOAN AND DISBURSEMENT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF AFTON, THE IOWA FINANCE AUTHORITY, AND WELLS FARGO BANK, N.A., AND AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE REISSUANCE OF \$195,000 SEWER REVENUE CAPITAL LOAN NOTES OF THE CITY. Tunnicliff seconded the motion. Roll call votes of ayes: William, Tunnicliff, Parrott, Burger & Cunningham. Motion carried

Discussion was held on raising the garbage rates due to the City receiving an increase from Waste Management of .81 month per residence. An Ordinance will be presented at the April 11, 2006 meeting increasing the rates by .50.

Williams moved to accept the 2004-05 audit report by Draper, Snodgrass, Mikkelsen and Co. Parrott seconded the motion. With roll call votes of all ayes, the motion carried.

Cunningham moved to approve the Class C Beer permit and Cigarette permit for Casey's General Store effective May 3, 2006. Tunnicliff seconded the motion. With roll call votes of all ayes, the motion carried.

Parrott moved to donate \$100.00 to the East Union Afton Prom committee. Burger seconded the motion. With roll call votes of all ayes, the motion carried.

A request was received from the Joy Group for an adjustment on a high sewer bill due to a stool not shutting off. Since the JOY Group is a non-profit organization and part of the City, Williams moved to make an exception and credit the JOY Group \$100.00 on their sewer bill. Tunnicliff seconded the motion. With roll call votes of all ayes, the motion carried.

Williams moved to approve City Clerk Kathy Flam to attend the semi-annual I.M.F.O.A. meeting in Des Moines in April. Parrott seconded the motion. With roll call votes of all ayes, the motion carried.

Parrott moved to dedicate a light pole in the City Park in memory of David Pugh for all of his contributions to the City of Afton. Burger seconded the motion. With roll call votes of all ayes, the motion carried.

Williams moved to adjourn. Tunnicliff seconded the motion. With roll call votes of all ayes, the Council adjourned at 8:10 P.M.
