

March 28, 2007

The Afton City Council met in special session at 5:30 PM March 28, 2007. Mayor Michelle Burger presided with Council members Ann Tunnickliff, Cindy Williams, Sherry Parrott, and Jeff Burger present. Dave Cunningham was absent.

Williams moved to approve the agenda and Parrott seconded the motion. Roll call votes of all ayes. Motion carried. Parrott moved to approve the minutes of the March 13, 2007 meetings. Williams seconded the motion. Roll call votes of all ayes. Motion carried.

Parrott moved to place Ordinance #173 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AFTON, IOWA, 1998, BY REDEFINING "DANGEROUS ANIMALS" AND ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION REGARDING VICIOUS DOGS on its second reading. Williams seconded the motion. Roll call votes of ayes: Tunnickliff, Williams, Burger and Parrott. Motion carried.

Doug Jones has agreed to serve a three year term on the Recreation Board. Williams moved to appoint Doug Jones to the Recreation Board. Parrott seconded the motion. Roll call votes of all ayes. Motion carried.

City Maintenance/Sewer employee Dick Stream was present to discuss the sewer machine and sewer problems on Pearl Street. Repairs for current machine would be around \$1300 and a new machine would cost \$30,000. The company that sells the machines will have two used machines available in April. Williams suggested tabling discussion until we could get prices on the used machines.

The City is having problems again with the Pearl Street sewer line. The Council decided an interceptor is needed on the Afton Care Center's private line to prevent future problems. The Council requested the City Clerk compose a letter to the Afton Care Center and send a copy of Ordinance 96.05 regarding interceptors. The Council is requesting the interceptor be installed within sixty days.

Tunnickliff moved to adjourn. Williams seconded the motion. Roll call votes of all ayes, the Council adjourned at 5:50 PM.
