

Camper Registration Policy

Effective 2006

All visitors wishing to place a camper on the campgrounds must register prior to setting up camper. *To register, the following information is needed:*

1. Camper make
2. Camper type (camper or combination camper/livestock trailer)
3. Camper license plate information
4. Owner of camper
5. Name, address, and telephone number of registrant
6. Names of those expected to occupy camper during fair

Fee for camping will be \$63.00. **This fee must be sent with registration information.** Payment will be by check or money order made payable to Union County Fair.

Camping requests with incomplete information or without payment will be discarded without further notification to registrant.

If camping request is granted, camper registrant will receive, by mail, a permit card which must be displayed in a road facing window of the camper while it is on our campgrounds.

All camping lots will be numbered and the lot number will appear on the permit card. Lot numbers will be assigned by the board or its designees. Preference for end lots will be given to combination camper/livestock trailer units. If campers desire to be on lots next to each other, both camper requests should arrive in the same envelope.

Campers must be parked only within confines of correct lot number and must not intrude into any other lot.

Campers must not be placed in the campground before 8:00 A.M. Friday immediately prior to the start of the fair, and shall be removed by 6:00 P.M. Saturday immediately following the fair. **No exceptions.** Electricity will be available during this time period.

Campers in violation of this policy will be removed from the campgrounds. Means of removal (towing, dragging, etc.) will be at the discretion of the board or its designees. Registrant of the violating camper will be responsible for any cost incurred by the association, board, or its designees in the process of removing the camper. The association, board, or its designees will not be responsible for damages to any camper which occur while on the association's property.
