PUBLIC FORUM: No one present spoke.

OLD BUSINESS:

Police Chief Coulter went over his list of five nuisances and updated Council. 201 W. Kansas was given until 12/31/17 to secure the outside of their building during their hearing in September, but no work has been started. Council will have City employee put up snow fence around building and Coulter will talk to Fire Chief about signing something to post on the building. Hill mentioned a junk car and indoor furniture on patio to add to the list.

NEW BUSINESS:

Council reviewed the new livestock Permit Application form to be used. Hill moved to approve the new application form and Parrott seconded the motion. Roll call votes of all in favor and the motion carried. Council reviewed list of residential properties that currently have livestock and the City Clerk will send letters and the new permit application to seven properties with livestock. The Clerk was instructed to also send to two properties that have had livestock in the past for future reference only.

A sidewalk Assistance Application was received for 208 S. Browning. West Scott Street currently has a sidewalk in bad shape abutting this property and neighboring 302 S. Browning property that already has a nice sidewalk. Cunningham moved to fix the City section of sidewalk on W. Scott Street between these two properties. Burger seconded the motion. Roll call votes of ayes: Cunningham, Parrott, Williams and Burger. Abstain: Hill. Motion carried.

Council discussed IEDA new Community Catalyst Building Remediation Program that SICOG notified us about. A pre-application is due by January 29 and only one property can be submitted at a time. Council discussed the program requirements and a few properties that would qualify for this program. Cunningham moved to apply using 251 N. Webster and Parrott seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried. If denied an alternate property of 250 N. Douglas will be submitted if time allows.

Burger moved to appoint Jack Whited to fill Don Damewoods term on the Afton Housing Commission. Cunningham seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Parrott moved to approve the Financial Statements for the period ending June 30, 2017 prepared by our auditing firm of Gronewold, Bell, Kyhnn & Co. P.C. Hill seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Utility Clerk Walter prepared the 2018 Electric Rebate program for the Council to review. A few changes were made to the current rebate program and other items were added along with a new Business Rebate Program. Hill moved to approve the new 2018 Electric Rebates and Parrott seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Council reviewed the draft version of our ordinance codes as prepared by Simmering-Cory & Iowa Codification. Several changes and corrections were discussed. City Clerk Landers will contact Iowa Codification to go over changes on draft and proceed with next step of the final version and public hearing before it is approved.

City Clerk Landers administered the Oath of Office to newly elected Officials: Shelli Burger, Mayor; Jeff Burger, Council; and Sherry Parrott, Council.

Parrott moved to adjourn and Hill seconded the motion. All voted aye. Council adjourned at 7:35 PM.
