**PUBLIC HEARING:** At 6:32 PM Mayor Burger announced it was time for the Public Hearing on the Budget Amendment for fiscal year 2018-19. No one present had comments and no comments had been received at City Hall. Mayor Burger closed the public hearing at 6:33 PM.

**PUBLIC FORUM:** No one present spoke.

## **RESOLUTIONS:**

Hill moved to approve Resolution 2018-21 A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CURRENT BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2019. Williams seconded the motion. Roll call votes of ayes: Hill, Parrott, Burger, Williams and Cunningham. Motion carried.

Hill moved to approve Resolution 2018-22 RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF IOWA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (IEDA) COMMUNITY CATALYST BUILDING REMEDIATION PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION AND APPROVING CITY FUNDING AMOUNT. Williams seconded the motion. Roll call votes of nays: Parrott; ayes: Cunningham, Williams, Hill and Burger. Motion carried.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

Council reviewed nuisance report listing 4 properties plus numerous sidewalk snow removal notices. 250 N. Douglas was on the report and discussed. The owner feels the building is secure, but there have been complaints and concerns with it being a dangerous building. City Clerk will discuss options with City Attorney. Council would like owner to get a written professional's opinion on the building being secure and also proof of liability insurance for any damages the building might cause.

Council discussed doors for community center and reviewed two quotes for either two heavy duty residential doors or two commercial doors to replace the current front and back doors that are not holding up and leaking water. Parrott moved to approve the lower estimate from Berry's Home Improvements to install two Quality Glass commercial doors, hardware and repairing trim for \$9,950.00. Cunningham seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

City Clerk Landers has been working with SICOG and Iowa DNR on grants for small VFW building at 290 N. Douglas. The Iowa DNR has Brownfield Redevelopment Program funds that would cover costs 100% for asbestos inspection and a Phase I environmental site assessment before owning the building. Landers updated Council that quit claim deed has not been processed yet as City Attorney is having abstract brought up to date first. Two asbestos inspection and three Phase I ESA proposals were reviewed. Parrott moved to continue with grants and approve lowest bids of \$800 from Iowa Environmental Services for asbestos inspection and \$1,850 from GSS for Phase I ESA. Cunningham seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

The furnace at the City shop stopped working and has a cracked heat exchanger and needs replaced. We received two estimates for replacing the shop furnace and also the old furnace in the shop office. Parrott moved to approve the low bid of \$5,896.29 from J&J Plumbing for the shop office furnace and shop area heater. Cunningham seconded the motion. Roll call votes of ayes: Hill, Williams, Cunningham and Parrott; abstain: Burger. Motion carried.

Hill moved to approve Change Order No. 6 for a deduction of \$17,480.09 for Watts work on our 2015 electric project. Cunningham seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Hill moved to accept the Certificate of Substantial Completion for Watts Electric Co. work on the 2015 Distribution Upgrade project. City Clerk noted this starts the clock on the 12 month warranties. Cunningham seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Burger moved to approve the Primary Electrical Distribution System Mapping agreement with JEO Consulting Group for \$4,000. Hill seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Hill moved to adjourn and Burger seconded the motion. All voted aye. Council adjourned at 7:09 PM.
