No motion made on 2nd reading of Ordinance 264 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AFTON, IOWA, 2018, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FEES. Ordinance not approved.

Hill moved to set Ordinance 265 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AFTON, IOWA, 2018, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FEES on its 1st reading. Nixon seconded the motion. Roll call votes of ayes: Cunningham, Nixon, Hill, Kinyon and Burger. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Notice to Abate Nuisance for 100 W. Iowa was mailed certified return receipt and the post office made 3 attempts to deliver and returned undelivered after the February Council meeting. Police Chief McGuire will personally serve the property this month as recommended by City Attorney Hardisty.

Discussed adding a park sidewalk. Nixon moved to proceed with a wavy sidewalk that extends from bandstand concrete slab sidewalk in middle going east with curves to butterfly garden then outlet to basketball court and splashpad using \$2,500 of city sidewalk funds, if any left, or LOST funds and applying for grant for balance. Estimated cost up to \$4,500. Kinyon seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried. Clerk Landers to get written estimates, design and apply for grants.

NEW BUSINESS:

Due to neighbor disputes/issues and a future connection of a property sewer line, the City had Garden and Associates locate a survey pin at S. Clayton and Washington Street intersection from a past recorded survey in order to make sure the sewer connection was on city property and not the neighbor's property. It was discovered there is a fence located in Washington Street so City Attorney Weeks was contacted regarding the fence issue. Weeks will compose a letter to be sent to the property owners at 508 S. Clayton asking if they have any contrary information on the fence and if not to remove the fence from Washington Street. If not moved the city will take steps to remove and charge services to property owner. Nixon moved to proceed with City Attorney Weeks legal recommendations and Burger seconded. They also would like to do signs along nature trail, place logs around for stepping blocks, and have City put up chains on west side so no vehicles can drive on nature trail. Cunningham moved to allow ADC to pursue all mentioned ideas at the lake. Burger seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Hill wondered if it was okay for them to set up a couple vendors in the Wi-Fi Center for Women's Day Out event on 4/1. Council was okay with doing this during events.

Nixon moved to approve Afton Community Clubs street closure request of E. Kansas in front of El Ranchito going east to include intersection of Webster on Friday, June 23, 2023 for a street dance. Burger seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Nixon moved to approve the Beer/Wine Permit for Afton Community Club Tuesday Night in the Park events on 6/6, 6/20, 7/18 & 8/8. Burger seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Burger moved to adjourn and Kinyon seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the Council adjourned at 7:15 PM.

ORDINANCE NO 265

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AFTON, IOWA, 2018, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FEES

Be it enacted by the City Council of the City of Afton, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SUBSECTION MODIFIED. Subsection 106.08 (1A.) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Afton, lowa, 2018 is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

1. Monthly Residential Fees

A. The fee for solid waste collection, recycling collection and disposal service, used or available, shall be \$20.75 for 96-gallon container and \$16.00 for 35-gallon container (for qualifying elderly or disabled residents). Fees are for each household for once weekly collection of solid waste and bi-weekly collection of 96-gallon recycling container by Jim's Sanitation.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

A survey was done, an employee of Garden and Associates came and verified said survey. The fence is located on Washington Street. As the fence is on a Street, the fence is owned by the City of Afton, Iowa.

The fence needs to be removed from the City property by May 1, 2023. As you know, the fence is on a City Street that has utilities in it as well. Because the Street has utilities in it, we cannot vacate the street and give any portion of it to the landowners. Because we cannot vacate the Street, the fence needs to be removed for liability purposes. The fence could potentially impede utility work that needs done. The fence could cause damage to someone but because the fence is on City property and the City is now aware of it, the City could be held liable for said damage if they did not remove it.

If they don't remove it, the City can remove the fence as it is located on City property. The City wants to give the landowners time to do it so that they can keep the material and save any charges that the City would charge them that would be associated with the removal.

If the Ripperger's have any citation/case law/authority as to what gives them authority to maintain the fence as it currently sets, the City would be happy to look into said authority.

If there are further questions or concerns please feel free to reach out.


